



Opening of Range under Covid 19

BMSSC has obtained approval through SASSCo and SASCOC from Department of Sport, Arts and Culture to open the range under strict Covid-19 rules.

- A limited number of people may be on the range at any one time. Hence a booking system will be instituted whereby one can book a 2-hour slot. The fee for members is R20 and for visitors R80.
- Members will be given preference hence visitors will only be allowed to make bookings from Thursdays every week
- All bookings will be handled on a first come first served bases
- Bookings can be done via email to info@bmssk.co.za or WhatsApp to 0733047510:
 - Specify preferred time-slot
 - Specify which part of the range you want to book in terms of Hunting Rifle Sighting in, Small Bore Handgun (incl open sight SBR), Small Bore Rifle and Air Rifle.
- The time slots are
 - 12h30 – 14h30
 - 14h45 – 16h45
- Please follow up on request if no feedback has been received within 2 hours.
- There will be no stands, paper targets, cello tape etc. available on the range. You need to bring everything you will require with you. The silhouette targets, however, will be set on the range as in the past.
- ***Shooting is only allowed up to 200m under the condition that you can only put up your target at the beginning of the 2-hour session and take it down after the 2-hour session.*** This is a time-saving measure.

Special notes:

- **Although it is uncomfortable, everyone MUST always wear masks. Please prepare yourself for this as one must get used to wearing a mask, glasses that fog up and shooting at the same time**
- No socialising is allowed – hence anyone is only allowed on the range for the time-slot booked. The member is allowed to arrive at the range 15 minutes before the time and must leave within 15 minutes of end time of timeslot
- Sanitising is of the utmost importance. Sanitising of hands must be done every time before resetting targets and when one return from setting up targets. Sanitising liquid will be made available
- The range officers will disinfect the shooting bays between sessions to further prevent infections from spreading.
- **Please perform self assessment before coming to the range. Do not come to the range if you show any of the known C19 symptoms.** You will be required to complete a self assessment questionnaire which includes tracing information at the range. Your temperature will also be recorded. For your convenience the screening form is included below. You can print the form and submit it at the range should you wish to do so.
